“The Serbian movie ‘Sisters’ depicts the tragic story of two sisters who fell into the hands of traffickers and enslaved into the sex trade. The story is based on a factual events and it mirrors the real nature of human trafficking in Serbia, where 90 per cent of trafficking victims are young women, who are sold for sexual exploitation. The documentary, which has a running time of 83 minutes, was released 2011 and premiered in Belgrade. The production was funded by the International Organization for Migration (IOM), the European Union and the Government of Serbia.
