Following the annulment of her father's victory in Nigeria's Presidential Election and her mother's assassination by agents of the military dictatorship, Hafsata Abiola faces the challenge of transforming a corrupt culture of governance into a democracy capable of serving Nigeria's most marginalized population: women. The Supreme Price received the Gucci Tribeca Spotighting Women Documentary Award and was named Best Documentary at Africa International Film Festival (AFRIFF).
