How to participate

If you are a student who is enrolled in a Masters or a PhD programme at an Austrian university you are invited to apply by sending an email to the United Nations Information Service (UNIS) Vienna (unis@unvienna.org) with the following information:

- If selected, what would you expect to get out of the Shadowing Programme? (max. 50 words)

PLEASE NOTE: The number of applications that can be accepted is limited, so you are encouraged to apply as early as possible. The deadline is 31 August 2018. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The Shadowing Programme is not part of a recruiting process. It is a day spending with a UN staff member and gaining exciting insights into a work day at the UN in Vienna.

How to know if you are selected to participate

The selection of students who can participate in the Shadowing Programme will be made after all registrations have been collected. The successful candidates will be contacted per email.

The Shadowing Programme takes place to help mark United Nations Day (24 October). It is coordinated by UNIS Vienna and organized in cooperation with all participating Vienna-based organizations.

The United Nations in Vienna

Vienna is one of the four headquarters of the United Nations, along with New York, Geneva and Nairobi. Since its opening on 23 August 1979 the VIC has become home to several different UN organizations. More than 4,000 employees from over 100 countries work for the 16 international organizations and units of the UN in Vienna. About a third are Austrians.
