Members of the United Nations Scientific Committee on the Effects of Atomic Radiation (UNSCEAR) will brief journalists on the Committee's latest report.

The report's two annexes address global levels of medical radiation exposure and exposures of the public and workers from various sources of radiation.

UNSCEAR is meeting in Vienna 16-20 August.

UNSCEAR was established in 1955, reporting to the UN General Assembly on levels and effects of radiation. Its authoritative findings led to the Partial Test Ban Treaty prohibiting atmospheric testing of nuclear weapons. Its findings underpin international standards for radiation protection.
